STUDENTS have donated £2,000 to a charity set up in memory of an ex-pupil.

Senior prefects and the vice captain from Maidstone Grammar School decided to support the Jeremy Willson Charitable Trust with the £2,000 they made from a fund-

raising event at the school.

The trust was established by Jeremy's family after his death in 2006 from new variant CJD.

The money raised came from the Challenger House day, which featured activities including an X Factor event and sporting fun.

Deputy head teacher Michele Anderson said: "We felt that the aims of this trust to help talented young people across the world are close to what we are trying to achieve within the ethos of Challenger House."
